

Most pictures in Gilpin Class A Provincial Grassland Park taken November 2008 represent small deciduous ravines. Typical of this Park, every readily accessible water source has been badly compromised by cows.

This area is easily observed from Highway #3 near the south end of the Park. The grassland faces south and during the heat of July-September the mean temperature is consistently hot, yet note the canary grass which is synonymous with damp soil.
